Due to the recent adverse weather conditions, the polyester concrete scope has been rescheduled to the following dates:

Construction Start Date: 12/10/24

Construction End Date: 12/12/24

Working Hours: 7:00am – 5:00pm

Affected Area: Residents and properties within 100 feet of the work zone.

What to Expect:

- There will be construction noise, vehicle movement, and possibly dust during working hours.
- Access to driveways may be limited at times, but we will do our best to minimize disruption.

Materials Being Used: This project will involve the use of **polyester concrete**, a highly durable and fast-curing material that provides long-lasting pavement surfaces. In addition, we will be applying a **methacrylate resin** as part of the overlay process, which helps to seal the surface, preventing water penetration and further damage to the roadway.

These materials are widely used in roadway construction and are carefully handled according to safety guidelines. While the installation process may produce some temporary unpleasant odors, rest assured that all materials used meet strict environmental and safety standards. Air quality will be tracked using air monitors, per the advice of a Certified Industrial Hygienist.
